

# The DRAGON POOL USER GUIDE 2023

Welcome to The Dragon Pool and thank you for completing your online registration. Please make your annual £30 membership payment via Bacs (Ref: Mem 23) or bring payment along to your first swim in a clearly marked envelope with your name to be left in the red tin by the coffee machine

You will be swimming at your own risk and are effectively taking responsibility for the pool while you are here.

If you are new to the pool, please text me the date and time of your first booking I will come and show you around the pool and give you a key fob.

## ***How to.....***

If there is no one swimming before you, the cover will be on the pool, to remove it use the silver wheel at the deep end.




To replace the cover please use the rope which is coiled in the corner of the deep end and clip it to the leading edge of the cover.



Then walk to the shallow end allowing the rope to play out, pull hand over hand until the cover is flush with the end of the pool before replacing the rope on its hook.

**PLEASE REPLACE THE COVER IF NOONE ELSE IS WAITING TO SWIM**

In the Winter you may need to heat the air in the enclosure:



When you arrive, turn the dial on the heater from off to heat, the heater will run until it gets to the correct temperature and will then switch on and off throughout your swim to maintain a comfortable heat. When you leave the pool, the heater may not be running but will still be switched on so please remember to turn the dial back to off before replacing the pool cover.

If someone is swimming before you, they may well have turned the heater on so please check before you leave even if it hasn't fired up during your swim (this happens if someone swims early and then the sun warms the enclosure).

With current fuel prices we really can't afford to carry the cost of the heater being left on so you will be asked for a £5 an hour donation and repeated offenders may have their membership revoked.

If you are swimming at night, you may need the pool hall lights on. They are located under the flood light in the shallow end of the pool hall. Please turn these off when you leave the pool as they are not designed for prolonged use. All other lights are on sensors so you can leave them on.



There are 2 changing rooms, although they say male and female, that is only for lesson times. You chose one of them to change in and leave your belongings in, if someone is swimming after you, they will use the other room.

There are lots of pool accessories including woggles, arm bands, balls etc you are very welcome to use anything, we just ask that you replace them after your swim and do not leave anything on the bottom of the pool as it destroys our in-pool vacuum
